
Local Patron

Thank you to everyone who participated in the recent strategic plan public survey and South Orangetown Libraries funding vote.

The vote results are in: 486 YES | 51 NO

The referendum that passed with your overwhelming support will increase South Orangetown Libraries' (Tappan, Blauvelt, Orangeburg, Palisades, and Piermont) total funding by an additional \$150,000. The Tappan Library will receive an annual increase of \$46,760.

These funds, along with your valuable survey feedback, enable the Library to continue to serve our community as a place to read, to learn, and to gather together.
