GOAL: Explore Alternative and Sustainable Funding Options

Actions:

- Continue to explore options and opportunities to consolidate with other So. Orangetown libraries.
- Work with the Town Supervisor and Town Board.
- Explore creating a Friend of the Library group.
- Explore a consolidated Special District or School District Public Library.

GOAL: Expand Services and Remove Barriers

Actions:

- Examine and adjust operating hours based on statistical use and patron feedback.
- Work with So. Orangetown libraries to attempt to streamline lending rules.
- Implement automatic renewals.
- Lower cost for replacing lost library cards.
- Eliminate fines for the majority of our physical collection.
- Reduce price for non-resident direct access card in order to increase patronage.

GOAL: Expand Programming

Actions:

- Work to create additional opportunities for collaboration with other So. Orangetown libraries.
- Work to create additional opportunities for collaboration and in partnership with SOCSD.
- Seek out partnerships with local businesses and offsite locations to expand the reach of the library into non-traditional spaces.
- Expand partnership with local daycare facility to increase early literacy outreach opportunities.

Goal: Expand digital offerings

Actions:

- Continue to develop online remote access, services and programming.
- Increase budget for all electronic resources.
- Examine digital usage trends and reallocated print budget to expand digital budget.
- Purchase more digital resources allowing for 24/7 services beyond traditional hours of operation.

GOAL: Increase Awareness

Actions:

- Increase electronic promotion of digital content and programming.
- Increase electronic promotion of newly released material.
- Create an online option for patrons requesting bestsellers through staff initiated reserves.
- Continue print newsletters.
- Create a more theme focused and dynamic newsletter.
- Increase newsletter print frequency (budget permitting).
- Create more in-house marketing and promotions of collections and services.

GOAL: Staff Training


Actions:

- Send professional staff to PLA and NYLA conferences depending on funding availability.


GOAL: Space

- Create outdoor hardscape element making full use of the grounds and our water/park setting.




If no, how would you like to see us expand or reduce our hours?

- Add hours






